Romance Scams

Criminals exploit the desire for love and connection while gaining the affection and trust of the victims. They craft online personas to



build a façade—manipulating victims into parting with money or personal information by preying on emotions. They often find victims on dating apps or by texting.

Tips to help you guard your heart (and wallet):

•Scammers often create ideal profiles to lure victims. If someone seems too perfect, it might be a red flag.

- •Beware of whirlwind romances and serious commitments very early on. This is a common tactic to prey on emotions.
- •Scammers usually have elaborate excuses for why they cannot meet in person, or via video chat.
- •Never send money or financial information to someone you haven't met in person.
- •The scammer may discourage you from discussing your relationship with friends and family. Don't be afraid to confide in others
- ·Look for changes in communication style. Inconsistencies may indicate multiple scammers operating the same profile.
